Pay rates for doctoral students at LUSEM

On 18 September 2006 Lund University signed a local agreement with the employee organizations on pay rates for doctoral students. Pursuant to this agreement reg.no. F 85 4974/2006, each faculty decides on the division for research studies into two or more stages.

Pursuant to this agreement, the Board of the School of Economics and Management (LUSEM) decides on the division of research studies into salary stages for doctoral students employed under a doctoral studentship within the School of Economics and Management. The salary ladder consists of three stages in which the doctoral student receives a salary increase according to the table below:

<i>Stage</i>	<i>Salary increase</i>
60 credits (hp)	SEK 600
120 credits (hp)	SEK 1100
180 credits (hp)	SEK 1100

Applications for a salary increase according to the stages above are to be submitted to the HR-department at the Dean's office of the School of Economics and Management. The application is to include a certificate from the supervisor confirming the doctoral student's progress in research studies and be endorsed by the head of department. The salary increase applies as of the month following that when the stage was completed, although at the earliest six months before the application was received the Dean's office.

This decision is be applied as of September 1 2019. The decision replaces the previous decision taken by the board of the School of Economics and Management on May 7 2009, reg.no. EHL 2009/90.
